The 31st Mazurian Lakes Conference on Physics will be held in Piaski, Poland, August 30-September 6, 2009. The conference is organized by University of Warsaw, the Andrzej Sołtan Institute for Nuclear Studies, and "Pro Physica" Foundation. Scientific Programme

Three main topics of the conference are:

1. Nuclear matter and hadrons
2. Physics with antiprotons
3. Physics with exotic nuclei

The programme will consist of lectures and seminars.

Allocated time for lectures is 40 min. + 5 min. for discussion. The time for a seminar is 15 min. + 5 min. for discussion.

Only computer presentations will be accepted. Speakers are strongly encouraged to use the conference laptop for their presentations. The presentation file in the PowerPoint or PDF format must be handed to the organizers on a USB drive or on a CD one day before the talk.

Proceedings

We will publish the proceedings as a separate volume of Acta Physica Polonica B. In order to maintain the high standard of Acta Physica Polonica B, potential authors are reminded that only novel, original work should be submitted. All papers will be refereed. They should be prepared according to the rules given at the: <http://th-www.if.uj.edu.pl/acta> (see: instructions for the authors). The deadtime for the manuscripts is October 30.
